Stepping-stone it is, indeed, but he uses it with difficulty and is assisted by it but little who cannot see behind its Pillars a rule of conduct for life;

who cannot visualize climbing the Winding Stairs as the pilgrimage we all must make;

to whom the Middle Chamber is only a chamber in the middle

and for whom the Letter "G" is but a letter.
